2012 Travel Baseball

In 2012, the Roland Park Baseball Leagues (“RPBL”) will sponsor teams to play in the Baltimore County Major League that play games on Sunday only in the 9/10, 11/12 and 13/14 age brackets. RPBL may field A and B teams in some age divisions if there is sufficient interest to do so. RPBL is also seeking coaches for the travel teams in each of the age divisions.

Age eligibility for travel teams is as follows: 9/10 team members must not turn 11 before May 1, 2012 and 11/12 not 13 before May 1, 2012. With regard to the 13/14 travel teams, a player may not turn 15 before May 1, 2012. A birth certificate or equivalent proof of birth date is required for participation in travel team tournaments. Players must attend at least one tryout session in order to be eligible to make the team.

Tryouts for the 9/10 and 11/12 teams are tentatively scheduled to be conducted at Gilman on Saturday, March 3rd and again on Sunday, March 4th. The 9/10 tryouts will be at noon on both days followed by the 11/12 tryouts at 2 p.m. on both days. The tryouts for the 13/14 travel will occur in February at a location and time to be determined. If interested in trying out for any of the RPBL Ranger travel teams, please return this form as soon as possible to confirm your interest.

Travel team games for all age divisions begin in April, and games and/or tournaments continue as late as early July. For the 9/10 and 11/12 age brackets, the travel players must also play on an RPBL “in-house” team. Players selected for the 13/14 Travel Team will be required to participate in the RPBL “in-house” teams, unless such a player is also participating in a middle school baseball program. In such an event, the requirement for participation in the “in-house” program will be waived (the “Middle School Waiver”).

During the Roland Park “in-house” season, Sunday-Only travel games generally are played at 2 p.m. Practices are scheduled as the coaches may feel the need. Once the Roland Park “in-house” season concludes, Sunday-Only travel games may be scheduled on weeknights, particularly during tournament play.

A serious commitment to a travel team is asked of both players and their parents for a three-month period. For the committed, travel team play offers a great opportunity to play baseball against players from other leagues. We welcome all interested players and parents at the tryouts.
